

**SOUTH AMERICA**  
South America is the fourth largest continent and covers an area of about 17,840,000 sq. miles. The population is 200,000,000. The principal products are sugar, coffee, wool, tin, copper, iron, lead, zinc, silver, gold, diamonds, and oil. The principal languages are Spanish, Portuguese, French, and Guaraní. The principal religions are Roman Catholicism, Protestantism, and Judaism. The principal cities are Lima, Bogotá, Rio de Janeiro, Buenos Aires, and Santiago. The principal rivers are the Amazon, the Orinoco, the Rio de la Plata, the Paraná, and the Uruguay. The principal mountains are the Andes, the Cordillera Occidental, and the Cordillera Oriental. The principal islands are the Galapagos, the Falkland Islands, and the Juan Fernandez Islands.
